Award :

Two scholarships of \$1,000.00 each will be awarded to 1 female and 1 male Metropolitan and USA Swimming senior swimmers who have been accepted to a college or university for the next academic year.

Eligibility :

The applicants must ~

- be in attendance at a state accredited High School.
- be currently registered as athletes in Metropolitan Swimming.
- have swum in at least 5 Metro sanctioned meets in each of the last two years.
- demonstrate leadership ability.
- participate in community service work.
- submit one letter of recommendation from a teacher, advisor or administrator.
- write a 250-300 word essay on the following topic: "How swimming has had a positive effect on my scholastic and personal growth."

Official Rules :

- All components of the application must be submitted in one package.
- Applications will be judged by a committee composed of the Committee Chairman, Area Chairmen and a Board Member of Metropolitan Swimming.
- Winners will be announced at the Metropolitan Swimming general meeting in May and **awarded** at the Metropolitan Swimming Hall of Fame Dinner.
