FORMAT This is an Open meet sanctioned by United States Swimming and Metropolitan Swimming with the following characteristics:

- Senior Mets qualification times will be used for entries (see event list).
- Long Course Prelims/Short Course Yards Finals
- 20 swimmers return to Finals in Bonus, Consolation, and Super Final (Top 4 in prelims).
- Distance events are timed finals swimming fastest to slowest, limited to the top 24 entrants.
- Entries will be seeded with the following priority LCM/YARDS

ENTRIES \$5.00 per event. Entry fee payment must accompany entries. Please, no phone or fax entries. Make checks payable to Asphalt Green, Inc. This meet will be limited to 250 entrants. Swimmers will be limited to 4 events per day.

DEADLINE All entries must be received by 11/03/03. Email entries are preferred. Please process your entries as soon as possible. Hy-Tek users mailing their entries are asked to include a hard copy of your entries along with your disk.

FACILITY For Prelims: 1 x 50-meter pool configured with Lanes 7 & 8 reserved for continuous warm-up and warm-down separated from the competition lanes with double lanelines.

For Finals: 2 x 25-yard pools, one configured for competition. Two 20-yard lanes and four lanes of the second pool will be available for continuous warm-up and warm-down.

Colorado Timing System 5000 will be used with a 15-line scoreboard. Hy-Tek Meet Manager computer program will be used to conduct the meet.

ADMISSIONS Adult Admission (17 & Over): \$4.00 per person  
Session Program: \$3.00

PARKING Participants and coaches are encouraged to use the Brittany Garage located on 92nd St between 1<sup>st</sup> & York Ave (under the last building on the left side of 92<sup>nd</sup> St). This garage gives a reduced flat rate of \$12.00 for up to 8 hours. Parking tickets must be validated at the admissions table on the second floor upon entry to the AquaCenter.

Street parking is available according to New York City regulations. Private parking is available at various other garages within a three-block area.

SPECTATORS Only swimmers, coaches, and officials will be allowed on deck. Everyone else must remain in the spectator area. Volunteer timers will be greatly appreciated. **NO SMOKING ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING. NO FOOD OR GLASS BOTTLES ALLOWED ON POOL DECK.** Teams are required to police and maintain their areas on the pool deck. Athletes, parents and children are restricted to the 1st and 2nd floors of the AquaCenter and are not authorized to be in any other areas of the Asphalt Green campus (the AstroTurf field, the Murphy Center and all other floors of the AquaCenter). Offenders will be ejected from the facility.

CONCESSION Refreshments will be available and must be consumed in the designated areas only. No food or glass bottles will be allowed on the pool deck or in the spectator area.

INSURANCE All swimmers in meet must be currently registered with USS through Metropolitan Swimming, Inc., or some other LSC. It is the responsibility of the individual athletes and/or the team they represent to be sure that they are registered.

RULES Current USA Swimming rules will govern this meet.

AWARDS 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> will receive awards. These will be given only to a coach or team representative at the end of each session. All awards for each team must be picked up; not just specific individual awards. No awards will be mailed or forwarded, except in the case of computer failure.
