RACE DESCRIPTION: Triangular course on Huntington Bay marked with inflatable orange buoys and/or anchored sailboats, swum counter clockwise, marks rounded counter-clockwise. The *finish* requirements to be given at the pre-race briefing.

It is required that all competitors be at the pier by 7:15 AM for check-in and briefing.

NOTE: Meet Swim caps will be provided **and** required to be worn for safety and identification purposes.

Swimmers are **not required** to have individual escort craft but are encouraged to have them, **provided** they are non-motorized. Only Meet officials and/or authorized safety personnel are permitted aboard the designated safety patrol craft.

TERMINATION: After the first Male and first Female have completed the race, all swimmers still on the course one hour later will be picked up by the escort craft. In the interest of safety, the Meet Safety Officer and/or the Meet Director reserve the right to end competition at any time either considers conditions warrant.

RELEASE AND WAIVER INFORMATION: Each competitor must complete and sign the release form attached and if under 18, must have a parent or legal guardian sign also. **NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED TO SWIM WITHOUT SUBMITTING A PROPERLY COMPLETED FORM.** A coach's signature is **not** sufficient. **MASTERS** swimmers must attach a photo copy of their current membership cards. **ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES.**
