This meet is held under the sanction of the Metropolitan Swimming, an association of USA Swimming, Inc.

Site: Arvin Gymnasium Pool, United States Military Academy, West Point. The pools are 8 lanes, 25 yards and 6 lanes 25 yards, with non-turbulent lane dividers and Colorado timing system. There is ample seating. *Allow ample time to pass through West Point Security Checkpoint at entry gates

Parking: Is available within a short walking distance from the pool.

Rules: US Swimming rules govern this meet. All events are timed finals.

Eligibility: All swimmers must be USS registered. Age as of the first day of the meet determines the competition age group. Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend.

Entries: **MUST** be sent on Hy-tek File. Include phone #, EMail and name of contact. Entry Files may be e-mailed, to westpointsc@aol.com however, waiver and payment must be received by entry deadline for entries to be recognized. Limit of 3 individual Events, per day, for Trials & Finals Events. **PLEASE NOTE: A club official must sign the waiver for the West Point Military Academy on the front cover sheet in order for your entries to be accepted.**

Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Metropolitan LSC teams will be entered in the order received by October 10th. All other teams (including late Metro teams) will be entered, in order received, after October 10th. Entry deadline for all teams is October 13th, however, meet may close sooner if entry limits (as defined by USA rules) are reached.

Awards: Ribbons 1-8 All entrants will receive a free Meet T-Shirt

Warm-ups: Metro warm -up procedures will be in effect for this meet. Both pools will be used for general warm-ups with feet first entry only. Meet marshals will be on deck to enforce warm-up procedures.

ANY SWIMMER CAUGHT SWIMMING UNDER THE BULKHEAD WILL BE DISMISSED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE MEET!

Seeding: On deck seeding will be in effect. Heat sheets will be posted around the pool deck.

Admission: There will be a nominal charge for admission and programs for each session.

Refreshments: Food and beverages will be available for sale at the meet and may be consumed in designated areas only. FEDERAL REGULATIONS PROHIBIT SMOKING IN ANY BUILDING ON WEST POINT AND WITHIN 50 FEET OF ANY ENTRANCEWAYS.
