ENTRY LIMIT

Swimmers will be limited to 4 events per day for a total of 8 events for the entire meet. Seeding will be by long course meter times only (please convert your own times if necessary).

BONUS EVENTS Swimmers will be permitted to enter bonus. There will be no bonus event time standards (coaches please use discretion). Bonus events will be awarded as follows:

1 qualifying time = 1 bonus event
2 qualifying times = 2 bonus events
3 qualifying times = 3 bonus events
4 qualifying times = 4 bonus events

FORMAT The AA times for the 13-14 age group from the 2009-2012 National Age Group Motivational Times will be used as qualification times for this meet. The host team reserves the right to enter swimmers with 13- 14 A time standards.

Finals will be set up as: 1 heat of the 400 events, 2 heats of the 200 events, 3 heats of the 100 events, 4 heats of the 50's.

DEADLINE Entries must be received by May 1st, 2009. Entries will be accepted in the order in which they are received. Cuts to keep within the time allowed for each session will be made as necessary. No session will exceed 4 hours.

FACILITY Prelims: 1 x 7-lane 50-meter pool plus 1 x 50-meter lane separated by double lane lines designated for continuous warm up/warm down. Finals: 1 x 5-lane 50-meter pool plus 1 x 50-meter lane separated by double lane lines designated for continuous warm up/warm down. Finals will be held in lanes 3-7.

RULES Current USA Swimming rules are in effect. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet.

SCRATCHES Scratches are due 30 minutes before the start of the Prelims session each day.

ELIGIBILITY All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. Registration will be verified with the Metro Office; no swimmers will be permitted to enter after the "recon" has been completed. Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend.
